Obsidian Energy has an excellent opportunity for a contract Road and Lease Coordinator in the Peace River operating area. Working in a high paced, high energy work team, the primary responsibility of the successful candidate will be to effectively provide for the safe and cost-effective operation and maintenance of our civil earthworks construction program, including our extensive road network, drainage systems and surface dispositions. The operations team ensures the superior performance of facilities by implementing cost efficiencies and maximizing production. The successful candidate must be willing to work extra hours and be on-call as required.

Responsibilities

Duties include the following, but are not limited to:

- Plan, execute and optimize routine grader maintenance;
- Plan, execute and optimize gravel hauls and spreads;
- Plan, execute and optimize dust control programs with calcium or water;
- Plan, execute and optimize vegetation plans and minimize non-compliance;
- Plan and execute required bridge and culvert inspections, maintenance, and minor repairs as regulated or best practices;
- Oversee, document and report on internal spill cleanup activities to realize most efficient results;
- Monitor all third-party spill responses, collect, and record details for regulatory needs;
- Support new road/pad layout reviews to ensure design is fit for purpose with operation's needs;



- Complete handover reviews with new road/lease construction to ensure construction is fit for purpose and identify any opportunities along with timelines;
- Liaise with development earthworks Team to align on design needs and any improvement opportunities;
- Liaise with third-party agreements team to ensure our roads and leases for third-party use have the appropriate agreements in place and third-parties are following all conditions;
- Liaise with regulatory team to plan, execute and optimize any required regulatory work;
- Monitor and maintain all signage on all OBE roads and leases;
- Plan, execute and optimize road, lease and drainage repairs as budgeted; and
- Assist with the development of annual OPEX and Maintenance CAPEX budget related to operations earthworks infrastructure.

Qualifications

- Previous road and lease construction and maintenance experience
- Minimum of a High School Diploma, GED, or combination of education and experience
- Possess excellent communication skills, a positive attitude, and the ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Self-motivated with a strong work ethic and the ability to work in an unsupervised work environment
- Strong troubleshooting and problem-solving skills
- Strong computer skills (proficient in MS Office Suite)
- Possess a valid Class 5 Driver's License - drivers abstract is required
- Core safety training preferred
